

PERENNIALS-1

Our perennials are priced based on the pot size and pot color with the 3 1/2" being the least expensive, then 4 1/2" black, green and terra cotta (in that order) and then the 6" and the larger tubs.

ACHILLEA x 'Coronation Gold' (Hybrid Yarrow)

Aromatic, deeply cut foliage; deep yellow flowers in July-Aug. Ht.: 36". Spread: 18". Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, containers, cutflower, dried flower, nectarous plant. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ACHILLEA x 'Moonshine' (Hybrid Yarrow)

Clump-forming habit; aromatic, gray-green, deeply cut foliage; flat clusters of canary-yellow flowers in July-Aug. Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Ht.: 18". Spread: 18". Use in the border garden, in containers, as a cut or dried flower and to attract butterflies. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ACHILLEA millefolium 'Paprika' (Milfoil Yarrow)

Aromatic, finely divided foliage; rusty orange-red flowers in July. Ht.: 24-36". Spread: 18"++. Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for the border garden, cutflower, nectarous plant. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ACHILLEA millefolium 'Summerwine' (Milfoil Yarrow)

Vigorous, mat-forming habit; aromatic, finely divided foliage; flat clusters of deep burgundy-red flowers, blooming in July. Ht.: 24". Spread: 24"++. Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for the border garden, cut flower, dried flower. Attracts butterflies. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ACHILLEA tomentosa 'Aurea' (Wooly Yarrow)

Aromatic, wooly, gray-green, mat-forming foliage, bright yellow flowers in June-July. Ht.: 6-8". Spread: 15". Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, rock garden, nectarous plant. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ACONITUM x 'Stainless Steel' (Monk's Hood)

Features masses of blooms with upright, clump-forming habit; deeply divided, glossy, gray-green foliage; open spikes of metallic, steel-blue flowers blooming in June-Aug. Ht.: 42". Spread: 18". Grow in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to full sun. Use in the border or woodland garden, and as a cut flower. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Terra Cotta Pot.

ACONITUM napellus (Monk's Hood)

Dark green, glossy, upright foliage; deep blue flowers in Sept. Ht.: 36-48". Spread: 12-18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for the border garden, cutflower. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ACTAEA racemosa, Cimicifuga racemosa (Black Cohosh, Fairy Candle, Bugbane)

PERENNIALS-2

Large, deeply cut, toothed foliage; a Wisconsin native plant; pure white flowers in July-Aug. Ht.: 6-8'. Spread: 24". Grow in rich, moist soil in part shade to part sun. Use for native woodland, border garden, cut flower. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Green Pot.

ACTAEA simplex, *Cimicifuga racemosa* 'Brunette' (Snakeroot)

Clump-forming habit; large deep bronze, deeply cut foliage; slender, open spikes of long, pinkish white flowers in July-Aug. Ht.: 48-60". Spread: 48". Grow in rich, moist soil in part shade to part sun. Use in the woodland and border garden, as a specimen or cut flower. Zone 4. Gallon Pot.

ACTINIDIA arguta 'Issai' (Hardy Kiwi Vine)

Self-pollinating, sweet, early-bearing plant. Without a male, the fruit is seedless; with a male the plant will produce larger and more fruit. Less susceptible to early frost damage than Arctic Beauty. Fragrant clusters of small white flowers in May-June. Grows to 15-25'. Grow in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to full sun. Use in the woodland garden, as a screen or for a wall cover. Zone 4. Gallon Pot from Bailey's

ACTINIDIA kolomikta 'Arctic Beauty' (Hardy Kiwi Vine)

Features edible, yellow-green 1" fruits on female plants in autumn with climbing habit; heart-shaped foliage, purple-tinged when young, becoming variegated with white and pink at the tips as it matures; fragrant clusters of small white flowers in May-June. Grows to 15'. Grow in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to full sun. Use in the woodland garden, as a screen or for a wall cover. Zone 4. Gallon Pot from Bailey's

AGASTACHE x 'Blue Fortune' (Hybrid Giant Hyssop)

Licorice-scented foliage, compact habit; spikes of deep blue flowers in July-Sept. Ht.: 24-36". Spread: 24-36". Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, aromatic, cutflower, nectarous plant, butterfly host. Zone 5. 4 1/2" Black and Gallon Pots)

AGASTACHE foeniculum 'Golden Jubilee' (Golden Jubilee Hyssop)

2003 All America Selection. Upright habit; licorice-scented, golden foliage; dense spikes of lavender-blue flowers in July-Sept. Ht.: 24-30". Spread: 10-15". Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part sun. Use in the border garden, as a cut flower and to attract butterflies. Zone 4. 4 1/2" and 6" Pots.

AGASTACHE urticifolia 'Honey Bee Blue' (Hyssop)

Long-blooming, blue flowers in mid-summer with bushy, upright, fragrant foliage. Ht.: 24-32". Spread: 24" Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part sun. Use in beds, borders, pots, in the butterfly garden or as a cut flower. Zone 5. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

AJUGA x 'Chocolate Chip' (Hybrid Bugleweed)

Mat-forming habit; small, narrow, rich, chocolate-brown foliage; small spikes of dark lavender-blue flowers in May-June. Ht.: 2-4". Spread: 18". Grow in rich, well-drained

soil in part sun to part shade. Use in the border garden, woodland garden or rock garden, or as a groundcover and to attract hummingbirds. Zone 4. 3 1/2" Pot.

AJUGA reptans 'Black Scallop' (Bugleweed)

Very dark, glossy, scalloped purple foliage with deep blue flower spikes in June. Ht.: 6-10". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use in the border garden, woodland garden or rock garden, or as a groundcover and to attract hummingbirds. Zone 4. Proven Selections Perennial.

AJUGA reptans 'Burgundy Glow' (Bugleweed)

White, pink and bronze, variegated foliage, mat-forming; blue flowers in June. Ht.: 4-8". Spread: 12-18"++. Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use in the border garden, woodland garden or rock garden, or as a groundcover and to attract hummingbirds. Zone 4. 3 1/2" Pot.

AJUGA reptans 'Gaiety' (Bugleweed)

Purplish bronze-green, mat-forming foliage, blue flowers in June. Ht.: 4-8". Spread: 18"++. Grow in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use in the border garden, woodland garden or rock garden, or as a groundcover and to attract hummingbirds. Zone 4. 3 1/2" Pot.

ALCEA rosea 'Chater's Double' (Garden Hollyhocks)

Shallowly lobed foliage; double mixed colors, flowers in June-July. Ht.: 5-6'. Spread: 24-36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for the border garden, nectarous plant, butterfly host. Zone 4 Biennial. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ALCEA rosea 'Antwerp Simplex Single Mix' (Garden Hollyhocks)

Shallowly lobed foliage; single mixed colors in June-July. Ht.: 5-6'. Spread: 24-36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for the border garden, nectarous plant, butterfly host. Zone 4 Biennial. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ALCHEMILLA saxatilis (Rock Lady's Mantle)

Palmate foliage with fine white margin; yellow flowers in June-Aug; grow in rich, moist soil in part sun to part shade. Ht.: 8". Spread: 4-8". Zone 3. 4 1/2" Green Pot.

ALLIUM afflatunense 'Purple Sensation' (Ornamental Onion)

Stemless habit; gray-green, long, strap-like foliage; goes dormant after blooming; 3-4" globes of many star-shaped, bright purple flowers in May-June. Ht.: 36". Spread 24-36". Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use in the border garden or as cut or dried flower. Zone 4. Gallon Pot.

ALLIUM christophii, syn. *Allium albopilosum* (Stars of Persia)

Stemless habit; gray-green, long, ribbed, strap-like foliage; goes dormant after blooming; 8-10" globes of many star-shaped, silver-lilac flowers in June. Ht.: 18-24".

PERENNIALS-4

Spread: 24-36". Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use in the border garden or as cut or dried flower. Zone 4. Gallon Pot.

ALLIUM giganteum (Giant Onion)

Stemless habit; gray-green foliage; goes dormant after blooming; 4" globes of bright rosy-lilac flowers in June-July. Ht.: 36-60". Spread 24-36". Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use in the border garden or as cut or dried flower. Zone 5. Gallon Pot.

ALLIUM senescens (Ornamental Onion)

Clump-forming habit; narrow, somewhat twisted, strap-like foliage; globes of pale rose-pink flowers in Aug-Sept. Ht.: 6-8". Spread: 6". Grow in average, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use in the border garden, woodland garden or rock garden, as an edging and to attract butterflies. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

AMORPHA canescens (Leadplant)

A Wisconsin native plant with upright habit; shrubby, delicate, silver-gray foliage; open spikes of small, pea-like iridescent purple flowers in July. Ht.: 24-36". Spread: 24-36". Grow in average, dry soil in full sun. Use in the native prairie and to attract butterflies. Very late to emerge in the spring. Zone 2. 4 1/2" Green Pot.

AMSONIA hubrichtii (Arkansas Bluestar)

Clump-forming habit; mid-green, willow-like foliage turning a stunning, bright golden-yellow in the fall; loose sprays of gray-blue flowers in May-July. Ht.: 36". Spread: 48". Grow in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use in the border garden, woodland garden, or a low hedge, in containers, as a cut flower and to attract butterflies. Late to emerge in the spring. Zone 5. 4 1/2" Green Pot.

AMSONIA tabernaemontana (Willow Bluestar)

Clump-forming habit; mid-green, willow-like foliage turning bright yellow in the fall; loose sprays of gray-blue flowers in July. Ht.: 36". Spread: 18". Grow in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use in the border garden, woodland garden, or a low hedge, in containers, as a cut flower and to attract butterflies. Late to emerge in the spring. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ANDROMEDA polifolia 'Blue Ice' (Bog Rosemary)

Semi-prostrate habit; blue, rosemary-like foliage; umbrella-like clusters of pinkish white flowers in May-July. Ht.: 12-16". Spread: 24-36". Grow in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to full sun. Use in the woodland garden, border garden or rock garden, and use as a groundcover. Zone 3. Priced as marked from Monrovia.

ANEMONE x 'Honorine Jobert' (Hybrid Japanese Anemone)

Vigorous, upright habit; dark green, lobed foliage; open clusters of single, white flowers blooming in Sept-Oct. Ht.: 32-48". Spread: 18" ++. Grow in rich, well-drained soil in

part shade to part sun. Use in the woodland or border garden. Zone 5. 4 1/2" Terra Cotta Pot.

ANEMONE hupehensis 'September Charm' (Japanese Anemone)
Slightly hairy, lobed foliage; deep rose flowers in Sept.-Oct. Ht.: 24-36". Spread: 18"++. Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for border garden, woodland garden. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Terra Cotta Pot.

ANEMONE multifida Rubra 'Annabella Deep Pink' (Red Fern-leaf Windflower)
Clump-forming habit; ferny foliage; open clusters of carmine-red flowers in May-June. Ht.: 12". Spread: 12". Grow in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use in the woodland or border garden. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Green Pot.

ANEMONE pulsatilla (European Pasqueflower) See: *PULSATILLA vulgaris*

ANEMONE sylvestris (Snowdrop Anemone)
Mid-green, lobed foliage, interesting, wooly seed head; creamy white flowers in May-June. Ht.: 12". Spread: 10-12"++. Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for the border garden, woodland garden, cutflower. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ANEMONE vitifolia 'Robustissima' (Grape-leaf Anemone)
Foliage resembling grape leaves; pink flowers in August- October. Ht.: 24-36". Spread: 12-18"++. Plant in average, well-drained soil in part shade. Use for the border garden. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Terra Cotta Pot.

AQUILEGIA x 'McKana's Giant Mix' (Columbine)
Delicate, fan-shaped foliage; mixed colors, flowers in June. Ht.: 24-30". Spread: 18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for the border or woodland garden, nectarous plant. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

AQUILEGIA x 'Pagoda' Series (Columbine)
An early flowering series, but with an extended bloom time; notable compact, uniform and well-branched. A profusion of 2" blooms hovers above the silvery green foliage. Available in blue/white and rose/ivory. Ht.: 14". Spread: 12". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for the border, woodland or rock garden, nectarous plant. Zone 3. Proven Winner Perennial.

AQUILEGIA alpina (Alpine Columbine)
Gray-green, somewhat waxy foliage; deep blue flowers in June. Ht.: 12-24". Spread: 12". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for the border garden or rock garden, nectarous plant. Zone 3. 3 1/2" Pot.

AQUILEGIA caerulea (Rocky Mountain Columbine)

PERENNIALS-6

Blue-green foliage; blue-spurred, white flowers in June. Ht.: 12-24". Spread: 12". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for the border, woodland or rock garden, nectarous plant. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

AQUILEGIA caerulea 'Red & Gold' (Rocky Mountain Columbine)

Blue-green foliage; bright red, long spurred flowers with yellow centers in June. Ht.: 18-20". Spread: 18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for the border, woodland or rock garden, nectarous plant. Zone 3. 3 1/2" Pot.

AQUILEGIA caerulea 'Songbird Mix' (Rocky Mountain Columbine)

Compact, clump-forming habit; blue-green foliage; open spikes of large, upward facing, long-spurred, mixed colored flowers; blooming in June. Ht.: 24-28". Spread: 18-24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for the woodland, border or rock garden, nectarous plant. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Green Pot.

AQUILEGIA canadensis (American Columbine)

Delicate, fan-shaped foliage; a Wisconsin native; red-spurred, yellow flowers in June. Ht.: 12-24". Spread: 12-15". Plant in rich, moist soil in part shade. Use for the native woodland, border garden, rock garden, nectarous plant. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

AQUILEGIA flabellata 'Blackcurrant Ice' (Fan Columbine Hybrid)

This true dwarf species of columbine is compact and well-branched with blue-green foliage that is less prone to insect damage than other species. Bicolor, short spurred flowers have creamy yellow corollas enrobed in rich purple petals. Ht.: 6-12". Spread: 9-12". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for the woodland, border or rock garden and in containers, nectarous plant. Zone 3. 6" Pot.

AQUILEGIA vulgaris 'Winky' Blue & White and Red & White (Granny's Bonnet)

With a slightly different habit than other columbines, the Winky series is compact and mounded. A good mix of bicolored flowers in June. Ht.: 18-24". Spread: 12-15". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for the border or woodland garden, nectarous plant. Zone 3. Proven Selections Perennial.

AQUILEGIA vulgaris 'Tower Dark Blue' (Granny's Bonnet)

Bluish green, clump-forming foliage; double deep, blue-purple flowers held upright in June. Ht.: 20". Spread: 15-18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for the border or woodland garden and in containers, nectarous plant. Zone 3. 6" Pot.

ARABIS caucasica compacta 'Snowcap' (Rockcress)

Gray-green foliage, white flowers in May. Ht.: 6-12". Spread: 12-18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for the border or rock garden, nectarous plant. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

PERENNIALS-7

ARISAEMA triphyllum (Jack-in-the-Pulpit)

Three-lobed foliage, orange berries; a Wisconsin native, purple-bronze flowers in May. Ht.: 18-24". Spread: 12". Plant in rich, moist soil in full shade to part shade. Use for the native woodland. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Green Pot.

ARISTOLOCHIA durior (Dutchman's Pipes)

Vigorous, twining vine. Large, heart-shaped, rounded, dark green leaves. Grows flat against a trellis. Offers dense shade. The brown flowers are insignificant and usually hidden by the foliage. Ht.: to 30'. Can be grown in sun or shade in any rich, well-drained garden soil. 2006 Plant of Merit. Zone 4. Gallon Pot.

ARMERIA formosa 'Joystick Mix' (Sea Pink)

Clump-forming habit; rounded tufts of grass-like, evergreen foliage; round heads of rosy red, pink and white flowers in June. Ht.: 15". Spread: 12". Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part sun. Use in the border garden, rock garden, in containers or cut and dried. Zone 4. 3 1/2" Pot.

ARTEMESIA ludoviciana 'Silver King' (White Sage)

Aromatic, silver foliage; gray-white flowers in July-August. Ht.: 36". Spread: 12-24"++. Plant in average, dry soil in full sun. Use for containers, cutflower, dried flower. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ARTEMESIA ludoviciana 'Valerie Finnis' (White Sage)

Vigorous, clump-forming habit; grayish-white foliage; dense wooly sprays of very small, yellow flowers in July-Aug. Ht.: 24". Spread: 18"++. Grow in average, dry soil in full sun to part shade. Use in the border garden or woodland garden, in containers or as a dried flower. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ARTEMESIA schmidtiana 'Silver Mound' (Satinny Wormwood)

Silver foliage; no flowers. Ht.: 12-18". Spread: 12". Plant in average, dry soil in full sun. Use for the border garden, containers, rock garden. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ARUNCUS diocus (Goat's-beard)

Divided foliage; plumed, white flowers in June-July. Ht.: 5-6'. Spread: 4'. Plant in rich, moist soil in part shade to part sun. Use for the border, specimen plant, cutflower. Zone 4. Gallon Pot.

ASCLEPIAS incarnata (Swamp Milkweed)

Narrow, lance-shaped foliage; a Wisconsin native; pinkish-red flowers in June-August. Ht.: 36-48". Spread: 24". Plant in rich, moist soil in full sun. Use in the native meadow, native wetland, border garden and to attract birds and butterflies. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ASCLEPIAS tuberosa (Butterfly Flower)

PERENNIALS-8

A Wisconsin Native Plant. It features ornamental seed pods with upright habit; small, lance-shaped foliage on dark stems; umbrella-like, branched clusters of orange flowers blooming in July-Aug. Ht.: 24-36". Spread: 24". Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use in the native prairie or border garden, as a cut flower and to attract butterflies. Slow to emerge in spring and difficult to transplant. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ASTER alpinus 'Dwarf Mix' (Alpine Aster)

Gray-green foliage, maturing green; mixed shades of blue and white in May-June. Ht.: 10-12". Spread: 18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for the border garden, rock garden, cutflower, nectarous plant. Zone 3. 3 1/2" Pot.

ASTER divaricatus (White Wood Aster)

Shiny, black-stemmed foliage; a Wisconsin native; small, star-like white flowers in August-October. Ht.: 18-24". Spread: 36". Plant in average, well-drained soil in part shade. Use for the native woodland, border garden, nectarous plant. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Green Pot.

ASTER dumosus 'Wood's' Series (Fall Aster)

Compact, dark green foliage; mildew and rust resistant; yellow-centered, clear pink, lavender blue or light purple flowers in Aug.-Oct. Ht.: 12-15". Spread: 12-18". Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, containers, nectarous plant, birds. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ASTER novae-angliae 'Purple Dome' (New England Aster)

Narrow foliage on woody stems; royal purple flowers in Sept.-Oct. Ht.: 18". Spread: 15-18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for the border garden, containers, cutflower, nectarous plant. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ASTER novae-angliae 'September Ruby' (New England Aster)

Clump-forming narrow foliage on woody stems; deep rose-purple flowers in Sept.-Oct. Ht.: 36-48". Spread: 18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for the border garden, cutflower, nectarous plant. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ASTER novi-belgii 'Red Alert' (New York Aster)

Fine foliage on woody stems; red flowers in Sept.-Oct. Ht.: 15-18". Spread: 18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for the border garden, containers, cutflower, nectarous plant. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ASTER oblongifolius 'October Skies' (Aromatic Aster)

Low-growing, mound forming foliage; a Wisconsin native plant; sky blue flowers in Sept.-Oct. Ht.: 18". Spread: 18". Grow in any, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for native prairie, border garden, cutflower, nectarous plant, birds. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

PERENNIALS-9

ASTILBE x arendsii (False Spirea)

Spread 24" Plant in rich, moist soil in part shade. Use for the border garden, dried flower, cutflower, nectarous plant. Zone 4. All in 4 1/2" Green Pots except where noted.

Deutschland--Dark green foliage; white flowers in June. Ht.: 30".

Fanal--Reddish-bronze foliage; dark red flowers in June. Ht.: 22".

Flamingo--Green foliage; bright pink flowers in June-July. Ht.: 30". Gallon Pot.

Glut (Glow)--Dark green foliage; dark red flowers in July-Aug. Ht.: 32". Gallon Pot.

Hyacinth--Dark green foliage; purple flowers in June-July. Ht.: 24-30".

Ostrich Plume--Medium green foliage; salmon-pink flowers in July. Ht.: 32".

Rhineland--Dark green foliage; rose-pink flowers in June. Ht.: 24".

ASTILBE x simplicifolia 'Key West' (Star Astilbe)

Clump-forming habit; distinctive bronze foliage; dense sprays of bright carmine-magenta flowers blooming in May-July. Ht.: 15-18". Spread: 12". Grow in rich, moist soil in part to full shade. Use in the woodland garden or border garden, or as a cut flower. Zone 3.

4 1/2" Green Pot.

ASTILBE chinensis 'Pumila' (Chinese Astilbe)

Ground-hugging, soft green foliage; pink flowers in Aug.-Sept.; grow in rich, moist soil in part shade. Use in the woodland or border garden, in containers, as an edging or groundcover and to attract butterflies. Height 8-12". Spread: 18++. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ASTILBE chinensis 'Purpurkerze' (Chinese Astilbe)

Clump-forming habit; distinctive bronze and green foliage; sprays of deep rosy purple flowers in Aug. Ht.: 42". Spread: 36". Grow in rich, moist soil in part shade. Use in the woodland or border garden, as a cut or dried flower. Attracts butterflies. Zone 4. Gallon Pot.

Because of our short growing season, the early and midseason bloomers are the best choices. Late season bloomers may not bloom before our first hard freezes. Once planted, all flowers and flower buds should be removed immediately. We allow them to bloom in the greenhouse so the customer is more easily able to choose the colors they most want. Plant them in rich, well-drained soil, in full sun to part-shade. If possible, avoid planting them where there may be too much artificial nighttime lighting from street or yard lights. The added light may disrupt the plant's normal bloom cycle. Until about July 1, at 2-3 week intervals, pinch back the growing tips to promote bushiness and, therefore, more blooms later. Keep well-watered during summer heat because the root system is rather shallow. After blooming in the fall, plants should be cut back to about 6 inches. A winter mulch is necessary and die-off is likely in the hardest of winters. To help ensure survival, first layer 3-4 inches of topsoil over the crown once the ground is frozen. Place a 4-6 inch layer of loose mulch, such as marsh hay or pine boughs over the layer of topsoil. Remove both the topsoil and the mulch in April before the new growth has started. The term "cushion mum" found on the label, simply refers to the fact that it's a low-growing, clump-forming variety. "Cushion" does not refer to flower form. Clematis are perennial vines that, once established, are fairly easy to grow. The amount of sunlight and the acidity of the soil are most important in deciding whether to attempt a clematis or deciding where to plant one. The acidity of the soil can easily be adapted by adding lime when planting. They require full sun to part shade to bloom best, but special care should be taken that the base of the plant is somewhat shaded by underplantings. Plant them slightly deeper than in the original pot to encourage basal budding below the soil line. Clematis are divided into 3 groups based on their flowering time (and, therefore, pruning time) and plant form:

Group I are early flowering evergreen species that are mostly from warm climates. They are not recommended for Wisconsin!

Group II produces solitary large flowers on the previous season's ripened stems. These plants should be pruned in early spring before the the new growth begins only to remove dead or weak stems or to shape the plant. Cut back healthy stems to just above a strong pair of leaf buds. This group may bloom a second time in late summer.

Group III flowers on the current season's growth. Prune in early spring before new growth begins. Remove all the previous season's stems down to a strong pair of leaf buds just above the base of the previous season's growth--about 6-12 inches above the soil.

EUPHORBIA dulcis 'Chameleon' (Sweet Spurge)

Upright habit; burgundy-purple foliage turning maroon in the fall; loose clusters of burnt orange flowers in April-May. Ht.: 12-18". Spread: 18-24". Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part sun. Use in the border garden or woodland garden, in containers, as edging or a cut flower. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Green Pot.

EUPHORBIA epithymoides, Syn. *E. polychroma*, 'Bonfire' (Cushion Spurge)

Deep purple, red and orange leaves with a touch of chartreuse are set ablaze with cracking sulfur yellow bracts in May. Mounded habit. Ht.: 18". Spread: 18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for the border garden. Zone 5. 4 1/2" Terra Cotta Pot.

FRAGARIA virginiana (Wild Strawberry)

A Wisconsin native plant. GERANIUM x 'Johnson's Blue' (Hybrid Cranesbill)
Divided, mid-green foliage, bright orange-red in fall; clear blue flowers in July. Ht.: 15-18". Spread: 24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Green and Gallon Pots.

GERANIUM x 'Jolly Bee' (Hybrid Cranesbill)
An outstanding, nonstop bloomer whose mounding, cascading habit not only looks great in beds, but also in containers and hanging baskets. Flowers are a deep blue and appear late spring into fall. Oval, basal, smooth foliage; white flowers in July-Aug. Ht.: 12-18". Spread: 24". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, cut flower, dried flower. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

GRASSES: All are available in 4 1/2" Black Pots and/or Gallon Pots. All grasses listed below are at least Zone 5 hardy and many are Native Prairie. Most grasses emerge on the late side in spring so be patient. Leave the foliage and flower stalks at the end of the season for winter interest, then cut back to the ground in spring before the new foliage emerges. For more grasses (including Purple Fountain Grass and Ornamental Millet), please refer to the annuals section under "Grasses".

A NOTE ON "PAMPAS GRASS":

We get many calls for Pampas Grass and it's difficult to know what the customer is actually looking for. True Pampas Grass is 'Cortedaria' and is NOT hardy in

zones colder than 8 (we're Zone 4-5). People could only have seen it in the south. But there are many grasses that are locally called Pampas Grass by mistake. Pretty much any plumed grass is being called pampas grass, from *Erianthus* (which is growing in the low area at the intersection of Stoughton Rd. and Nakoosa Tr.) to *Miscanthus sacchriflorus* (a very invasive grass growing in roadside ditches throughout the area). Neither of these should be recommended for the average garden because of their invasive tendencies. Instead, we recommend some of the other *Miscanthus* varieties. All have beautiful plumes and lovely fall foliage and most are very hardy and clump-forming rather than invasive.

ACORUS gramineus 'Ogon' (Variegated Sweet Flag)--A bright and beautiful grass with green and golden variegation and a mounding habit. Ht.: 10-14". Plant in rich, moist soil in full sun to part shade. An excellent plant for mixed containers. Zone 5. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ACORUS gramineus variegatus (Dwarf White-striped Sweet Flag)--Mounded, noninvasive rhizome. This old garden cultivar loves moist conditions. The arching sword-like foliage will light up shady corners, form attractive clumps, or add bold accent. Grows to 15" Zone 5. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

ANDROPOGON gerardii (Big Blue Stem)--A Wisconsin native plant with clump-forming upright habit; blue-green to silvery-blue foliage becoming red-toned in the fall; open spikes of purplish flowers in July-Aug. Ht.: 6-7'. Spread: 24-30". Grow in rich, well-drained to moist soil in full to part sun. Use in the native prairie, meadow, border garden, mass plantings, as a specimen and to attract birds. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

CALAMAGROSTIS acutifolia 'Karl Foerster' (Feather Reed Grass)--Rich green, upright, clump-forming foliage; pale purple flowers in July-Aug. followed by golden brown seed heads. Ht.: 5-6'. Spread: 24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, massing, specimen. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot and Gallon Pots.

CALAMAGROSTIS acutifolia 'Overdam' (Feather Reed Grass)--White-striped, rich green, upright, clump-forming foliage; pale purple flowers in July-Aug. followed by golden brown seed heads. Ht.: 36-48". Spread: 24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, massing, specimen. Zone 5. Gallon Pot.

CALAMAGROSTIS arundinacea *Brachytricha* (Fall Reed Grass, Diamond Grass)--

Features open sprays of wheat-colored seedheads with clump-forming, arching habit; rich green foliage turning bright yellow in the fall; fluffy sprays of green-

blushed pink flowers in Aug.-Sept. Ht.: 36-48". Spread: 24". Grow in rich, well-drained to moist soil in full sun to part shade. Use in the border garden or woodland garden. Great in mass plantings. Zone 5. Gallon Pot.

CAREX buchani 'Red Rooster' (Leatherleaf Sedge)--Upright habit, along with the bronze-red foliage with curled tips, creates a nice accent in mixed planters. Leaves are fine textured. Brown flower spikes appear in mid-summer. Grows to 16-24" Spread: 18". Plant in full sun. Zone 5. 4 1/2" Terra Cotta Pot.

CAREX morrowii 'Ice Dance' (Variegated Japanese Sedge)--Shiny dark green foliage with strong cream to white margins; insignificant brown flowers in June. Ht.: 12". Spread: 12-18". Grow in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for border garden, edging, groundcover. Zone 5. 4 1/2" Terra Cotta Pot.

CAREX oshimensis 'Evergold' (Variegated Japanese Sedge)--Bright creamy yellow, center-striped foliage; small spikes of brownish flowers. Ht.: 8-12" Spread: 12". Plant in rich, moist soil in sun to part shade. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

CHASMANTHIUM latifolium (Northern Sea Oats)--Upright, arching habit. Treasured for its showy, pendulous flowers, beautiful arching seed heads and slender, bamboo-like foliage that changes from green to copper to rich brown. Flourishes in containers or in the landscape and offers great winter interest. Plant in full sun to part shade. 30-36" tall. Zone 3. Gallon Pot

DESCHAMPSIA caespitosa 'Bronze Veil' (Tufted Hair Grass)
Clump-forming, densely tufted habit; dark green foliage; open sprays of weeping bronze-green maturing bronze-yellow flowers in July-Aug. Ht.: 30-36". Spread: 24-36". Grow in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use in the border garden or woodland garden, for mass planting and to attract birds. Zone 4. Gallon Pot.

DESCHAMPSIA caespitosa 'Schottland' (Tufted Hair Grass)
Clump-forming, densely tufted habit; dark green foliage; open sprays of light green maturing golden flowers in July-Aug. Ht.: 42-66". Spread: 24-36". Grow in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use in the border garden or woodland garden, for mass planting and to attract birds. Zone 4. Gallon Pot.

FESTUCA glauca (Blue Fescue)--Medium textured, soft powdery blue foliage, finely textured, cream-colored seed heads; bluish to purplish flowers in June. Ht.: 10-12". Spread: 12". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for containers, edging, groundcover. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

FESTUCA glauca 'Elijah Blue' (Blue Fescue)--Medium textured, soft powdery blue foliage, finely textured, cream-colored seed heads; bluish to purplish flowers in June. Ht.: 10-12". Spread: 12". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for containers, edging, groundcover. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

HAKONECHLOA macra Aureola (Golden Variegated Hakone Grass)--Clump-forming, mounded habit; bright golden-yellow foliage streaked with green, intense pinkish red in fall; open sprays of pale green maturing red-brown flowers in Aug.-Sept. Ht.: 18-24". Spread: 18-24". Grow in rich, moist soil in part sun to part shade. Use in the border, woodland, containers or as a specimen. Zone 5. Gallon Pot.

HELICTOTRICHON sempervirens 'Sapphire' (Blue Oat Grass)
Features golden wheat-colored seed heads with clump-forming, densely tufted habit; semi-evergreen, metallic blue, coarse foliage; open, one-sided, sprays of blue flowers in July-Aug. Ht.: 36-48". HIEROCHLOE odorata (Sweet Grass) For more info, see our Herb Section.
A Wisconsin native plant with vigorous upright habit; grassy foliage that is sweet smelling and curly when dried; open sprays of bell-like, bronze to purple flowers in June-Oct. Ht.: 24". Spread: 12"++. Grow in any moist to wet soil in full sun to part shade. Use in the native meadow, native woodland or bog garden, for mass planting, or on the shoreline. JUNCUS effusus 'Blue Arrows' (Soft Rush)--Upright divergent. Known for its narrow, soft, round stems and vertical growth. Medium green foliage turns yellowish brown after first frost. MISCANTHUS sinensis 'Silberfeder' (Maiden Grass)--Medium green foliage turning golden in fall; silver white flowers in Sept.-Oct Ht.: 6-7'. Spread: 24-36".

VERONICA latifolia 'Crater Lake Blue' (Hungarian Speedwell)

Shiny green, mat-forming foliage; intense blue flowers in June-July. Ht.: 12-18". Spread: 12-18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, rock garden. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

VERONICA peduncularis 'Big Blue' (Blue Speedwell)

Mat-forming, trailing habit: durable, evergreen foliage turning bronze in winter; short, open spikes of bright blue flowers with a white eye in May-June. Ht.: 8-12". Spread: 12". Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part sun. Use in the border garden, as an edging or groundcover, in containers, and to attract butterflies. Zone 4. Proven Winners Perennial.

VERONICA spicata 'Pink Goblin' (Spike Speedwell)

Clump-forming habit; gray-green, upright foliage; dense spike of pink flowers in June-July. Ht.: 16". Spread: 10-15". Grow in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part sun. Use in the border garden, in containers, as a cutflower and to attract butterflies. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black.

VERONICA spicata 'Red Fox' (Spike Speedwell)

Clump-forming habit; gray-green, upright foliage; dense spike of rosy red flowers in June-July. Ht.: 15-18". Spread: 10-15". Grow in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part sun. Use in the border garden, in containers, as a cutflower and to attract butterflies. Zone 4. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

VERONICASTRUM virginicum Blue (Culver's Root)

Gray-green, upright, clump-forming foliage; branched spikes of light blue flowers in Aug.-Sept. Ht.: 48-60". Spread: 24-36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for native prairie, back of the border. Zone 3. 4 1/2" Black Pot.

VINCA minor 'Atropurpurea', Syn. *V. minor* 'Purpurea' and 'Rubra' (Myrtle, Periwinkle)
Glossy, mat-forming, evergreen foliage; dark, plum-purple flowers in May-June. Ht.: 6". Vigorous spreader. Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part sun. Use for groundcover. Zone 4. 3 1/2" Pot.

VINCA minor 'Blue and Gold' (Myrtle, Periwinkle)

Glossy, mat-forming, evergreen foliage with irregular gold variegation; blue-violet flowers in May-June. Ht.: 6". Vigorous spreader. Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part sun. Use for groundcover. Zone 4. 3 1/2" Pot.

VINCA minor 'Bowles Variety' (Myrtle, Periwinkle)

Glossy, mat-forming, evergreen foliage; deep lilac-blue flowers in May-June. Ht.: 6-8". Vigorous spreader. Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part sun. Use for groundcover. Zone 4. 3 1/2" Pot.

VIOLA--Sold as annuals with pansies. Self-sows so often mistaken for a perennial.

VIOLA pedata (Bird's-foot Violet)

Deeply divided, clump-forming foliage, a Wisconsin native plant; edible, light blue to dark violet flowers in Apr.-June, reblooming. Ht.: 6-10". Spread: 10". Grow in rich,

well-drained soil in part shade to full shade. Use for native meadow, rock garden. Zone 4.

WISTERIA macrostachya 'Aunt Dee' (Kentucky Wisteria)

The only type of wisteria hardy in Wisconsin. A twining vine that needs support on which to grow. Slightly fragrant, light purple flowers are borne in 7-12" clusters in May. Foliage is green. Ht.: 15-25'. Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Zone 4. Gallon Pot.

YUCCA filamentosa (Adam's Needle)

Stemless habit; pointed gray-green foliage; spike-like sprays of large, nodding, bell-shaped, creamy white flowers in July. Ht.: 48-60". Spread: 24-36". Grow in average, dry soil in full sun. Use in the border garden, as a specimen and to attract butterflies. Zone 4.

4 1/2" Black Pot.

YUCCA filamentosa 'Bright Edge' (Adam's Needle)

Pointed, dark green foliage with bright gold edge; creamy-white flowers in July. Ht.: 48-60". Spread: 24-36". Grow in average, dry soil in full sun. Use for border garden, specimen. Zone 4. Gallon Pot.
